The Migrant Out of School Youth Initiative identifies and recruits high school-age youth not enrolled in school. The OSY recruiter will assist districts in ensuring that migrant out-of-school youths have access to academic support, resources and services based on identified needs.





MIGRATORY WORK REFERS TO:

- › Temporary or seasonal employment in fishery or agricultural work.
- › The production or initial processing of crops, livestock, dairy products and fish.
- › Cultivation and harvesting of trees.

HOW WE CAN HELP:

OSY provides academic support, resources, and services based on individual student needs including:

- › High school diploma, GED (High School Equivalency), and/or ESL Classes
- › Instruction specific to vocational exploration, technology, and life skills
- › College enrollment and post secondary educational opportunities
- › Community resource referrals such as medical, dental, vision, etc.

ARE YOU OR SOMEONE YOU KNOW:

- › Under the age of 22 and lack a U. S. issued high school diploma or GED, and
 - › Have moved in order to accompany or join a parent or guardian who is a migratory worker.
 - › Have moved specifically to work in agriculture, dairy, or fishery with or without their legal guardians.
 - › Are traveling on his/her own or with a group of workers/crew leader.
